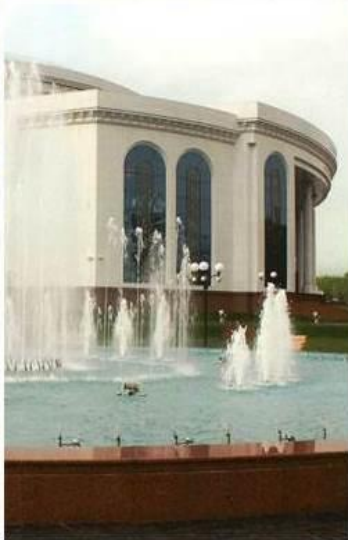
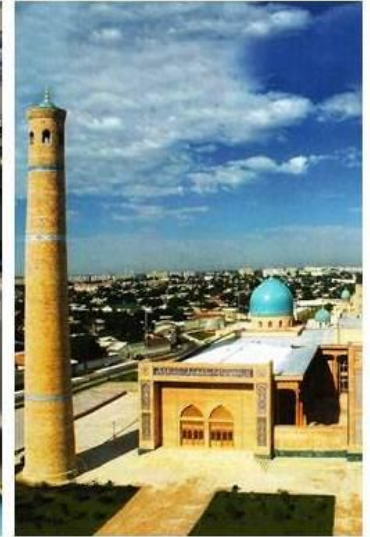

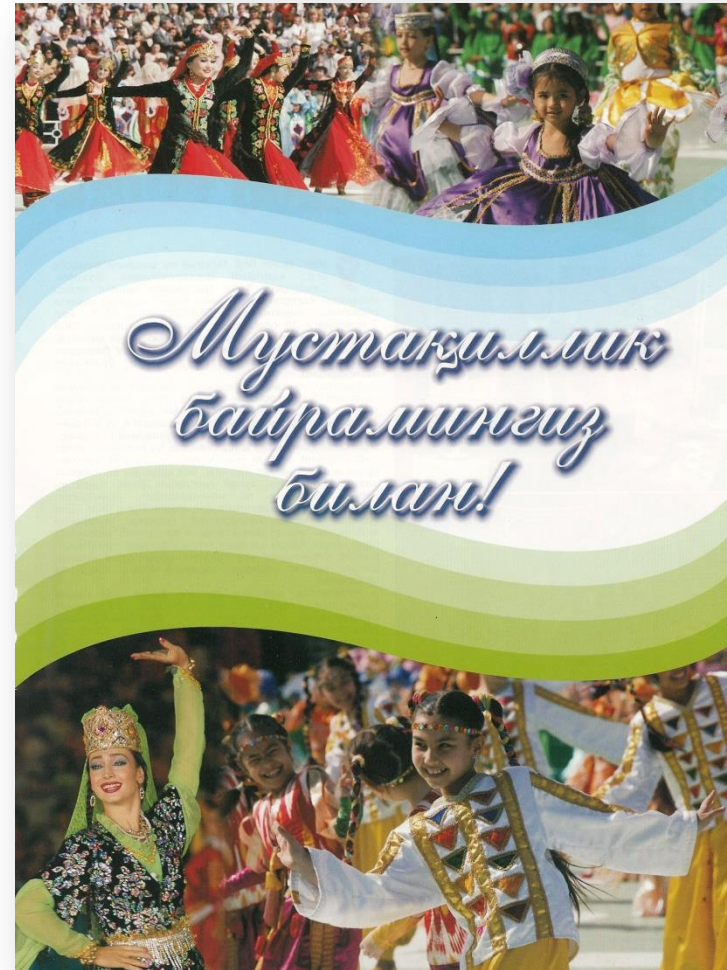


# The Republic of Uzbekistan

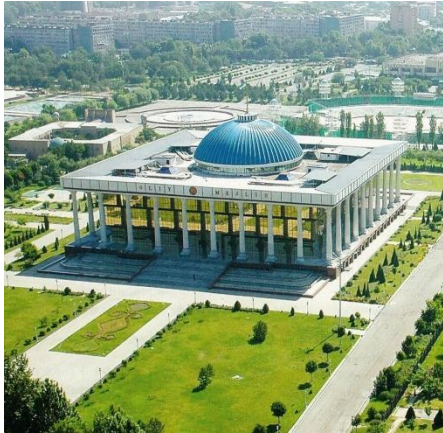

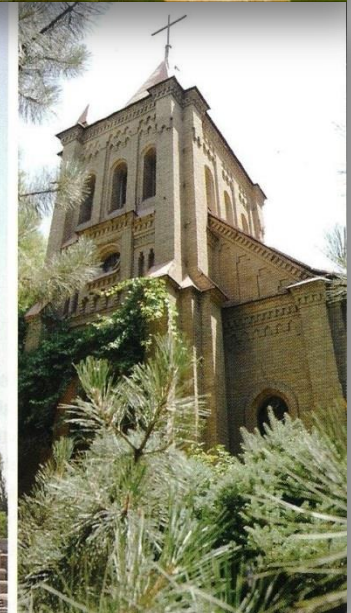
